IBD MONITORING FUND

The Crohn's and Colitis Society of Singapore (CCSS) is pleased to announce the establishment of the IBD Monitoring Fund. The fund assists families only after IBD has been established. It is important for the IBD patient to **undergo tests to monitor his condition** which helps in the **management of illness.**

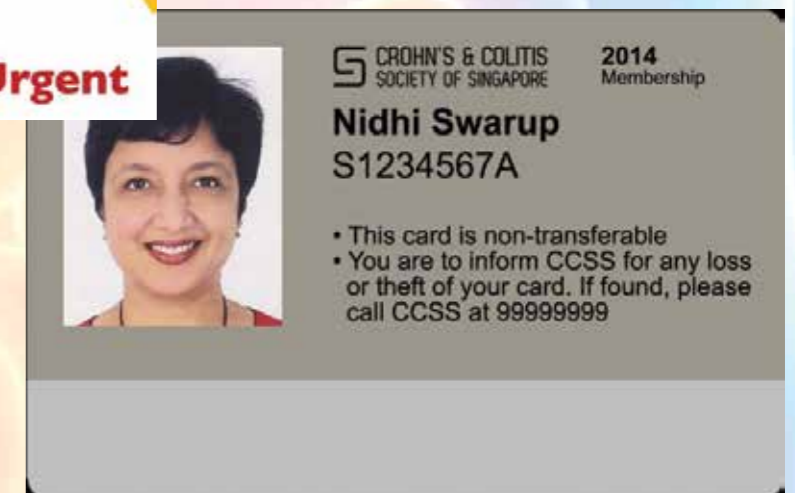


CCSS was formed to serve persons with Inflammatory Bowel Disease (IBD) of which Crohn's disease and Ulcerative colitis are the two most common managing the emotional issues associated with these chronic illnesses.

Going a step further, the Society will be providing financial assistance through the IBD Monitoring Fund. This is a pilot project for three years and we plan to support 50 IBD patients a year. This will cost CCSS \$90,000 in total of which **\$50,000 has been raised** so far thanks to strong support from Rotary, various companies and individual donors.

CAN'T WAIT CARD

The Crohn's & Colitis Society of Singapore (CCSS) supports patients diagnosed with Crohn's Disease and Ulcerative Colitis. These are non-infectious, incurable **illnesses affecting the digestive tract.**



Although not life-threatening illnesses, patients' condition is such that they would have an URGENT need to use the restroom or toilet.

Often the condition forces patients to quickly use the nearest restroom. CCSS together with The Restroom Association of Singapore has launched the **"Can't Wait Card"**.

The photo-ID card identifies the holder as a Crohn's disease or Ulcerative colitis patient registered with the charity. We seek your co-operation to allow the holder of this card **priority in using public toilets.**

Kindly support this initiative or **"Do your part"** by giving patients suffering from Crohn's disease or Ulcerative colitis priority to use the restroom.
